We are changing the way we send your Web access code

This is the last year you will receive a personalized T4 Summary with your Web access code pre-printed at the top. For the 2008 tax year, you will receive (in December 2008), a letter which will include your Web access code.

Filing the T4 information return

For details about completing and filing the T4 slip and summary, visit www.cra.gc.ca/slips.

Codes

The following codes were optional for 2006 but are mandatory for 2007.

- Code 81, Placement or employment agency workers gross earnings
- Code 82, Drivers of taxis or other passenger carrying vehicles gross earnings
- Code 83, Barbers or hairdressers gross earnings
- Code 84, Public transit pass. Under proposed legislation, the public transit pass will be expanded to include additional costs. For details, see www.cra.gc.ca/slips and select "What's new."

Code 85, Employee paid premiums for private health services plans, is still optional.

New income exclusion (Code 30 - Housing, board, and lodging)

There is a new income exclusion for housing allowances paid by a registered charity or non-profit organization to players on sports teams or members of recreation programs. Certain conditions, including an age restriction, apply. For details, see www.cra.gc.ca/payroll and select "What's new."

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Information for electronic filers

T4 Web Forms

If you are filing 1-3 T4 slips, you can use our T4 Web Forms application. Complete and submit your T4 slips and summary online. Print T4 slips for your employees. For details, visit www.cra.gc.ca/webforms.

Internet file transfer (XML)

You can file your T4 return by Internet file transfer. Starting January 2008, if you use payroll, commercial, or in-house developed software to manage your business, you can file up to 5 MB (approximately 3,500 slips). See www.cra.gc.ca/file-xml.

T4 Desktop Application

If you are filing 1-70 T4 slips, you can use our T4 Desktop application. See www.cra.gc.ca/t4internet.

My Business Account (MyBA)

MyBA allows you to file your return using T4 Web forms or Internet file transfer without a Web access code. The maximum file size for Internet file transfer through MyBA is approximately **3.5 MB**. For details about filing through MyBA, see www.cra.gc.ca/mybusinessaccount.
