- consists of 180 minutes of in-class instruction and student exercises
- flexible you can teach it in economics, accounting, business, mathematics, consumer education, social studies, and second language courses

Responsible Citizenship and Canada's Tax System

This learning product explores the relationship between income taxes and Canadians' quality of life.

For students:

- examines where your tax dollars go
- explains your rights and responsibilities as taxpayers
- increases your awareness of issues related to the underground economy and its impact on our society

For educators:

- you can choose and customize from 180 minutes of in-class instruction and student exercises
- designed to meet a wide range of teaching and learning preferences
- flexible you can use it alone or as an introduction to Teaching Taxes

This online course is designed for anyone who wants to learn about Canada's tax system and how to prepare a simple income tax and benefit return.

- introduces you to Canada's tax system
- teaches you how to prepare and file a simple tax return
- self-paced learning modules
- approximately 60 to 90 minutes to complete
