



Registration of Family Support Payments

Use this form to register your court order or written agreement if:

- your order or agreement was made after April 1997 and it specifies support payments for a **spouse** or **common-law partner**; or
- your order or agreement was made before May 1997, it specifies support payments for a spouse **or** clearly specifies separate amounts for a spouse and for a child, and:
 - you have filed Form T1157, *Election for Child Support Payments*; or
 - your order or agreement was changed after April 1997 to increase or decrease the amount of child support payable.

Complete a separate form for each order or agreement you are registering.
