If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2016, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$35,927 and \$81,847, calculate your partial claim as follows:

<b>Line 8 of Form TD1NT – Caregiver amount</b>			
If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$15,940 and \$20,607, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,667)	=	3	
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of Form TD1NT for this dependant.	-	4

<b>Line 9 of Form TD1NT – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older</b>			
You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1NT. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$6,622 and \$11,290, calculate your partial claim as follows:
